
1 Introduction

This documentation describes how to use the Siteimprove plug-in for the FirstSpirit CMS. This document describes the functions for analysing the FirstSpirit content through the Siteimprove services.

2 Using the Plug-Ins



2.1 Content Creator

The plug-in is intended solely for use in the Content Creator. After successfully installing the plugin, the following actions appear in the action menu:



2.1.1 Siteimprove – Open Preview Results

The first click on this action opens two windows:

1) Internal FS-window	2) Browser-Window
View of the analysis results	Login
	

The login is done with your customized Siteimprove account. If the window is accidentally closed, it can be reopened using the button on the right side of the internal window.


After successful login, the analysis results are displayed for this page. From here the detailed analysis results in Siteimprove can be achieved.

2.1.2 Siteimprove – Open Live Results

The steps for analyzing the live site are identical to the previous step, but in this case the live pages, which are already published, will be analyzed.

2.1.3 Siteimprove – Generate and review this Page

After clicking on this action, the following window opens:



Here you can select the "Preview" or "Live" stage. After selecting one option, the corresponding task for generation is triggered. An initiated job is indicated by a message.

The results of the generation are not visible to pure Content Creator users. When the analysis is completed by Siteimprove, it can be identified by comparing the displayed timestamp of the last analysis.
